WEDDINGS AND VOW RENEWALS AT THE LITTLE BROWN CHURCH

A CHRISTIAN WEDDING.

The Little Brown Church in the Vale is an active Christian Congregational Church. As such, your wedding or vow renewal will be performed by our pastor, and will be set within the context of the Christian Faith. Your vows will be made before God, and those present at your wedding ceremony. During the ceremony our pastor will share a brief instruction and encouragement from the Bible, and prayer will be offered for you (including the Lord's Prayer) for your special day, and for your future life together. The service is generally traditional in content, however our pastor personalizes each wedding, creating an intimate and meaningful experience for each couple. ABOUT THE CHURCH

The Little Brown Church in the Vale is set among 10 acres of beautiful gardens and grounds just outside of the City of Nashua, in Northeast Iowa. Great care has been taken over the years to maintain the originality of the building and grounds. A wedding or vow renewal at The Little Brown Church in the Vale is a journey back in time!

CHURCH GROUNDS & PARKING:

- There is ample parking for cars, trucks, and buses. Parking spaces are located both at the north side of the church and directly across from the church.
- Bridal limousines may pull up directly in front of the church.
- Consumption of alcohol is not allowed on the church grounds.
- Smoking is permitted on the church grounds – not in the church. We encourage those who smoke to do so at a distance from the front door of the church.

- We do not allow rice, bird seed, or confetti to be thrown as the bride and groom exit the church – bubbles are fine!
- Please make sure that any trash is disposed of before leaving the property.

INSIDE THE CHURCH:

- The maximum capacity of the church is 100 people.
- Due to limitations of space at the front of the church we are only able to have six (6) members in the wedding party standing with the pastor. This would normally be the bride & groom plus two bridesmaids and two groomsmen. Other members of the wedding party can walk the aisle ahead of the bride but would need to be seated in the front side pews as soon as they reach the front of the church – and before the bride walks down the aisle.
- Because of space limitations, the front center pew is left unused. Immediate family members (moms and dads etc.) can be seated from the second center pew.
- As the church does not have a center aisle, wedding parties walk down the aisle on the right hand side of the sanctuary. The aisles and the area at the front of the church are relatively narrow. We recommend that brides wearing a wedding dress with a wide or long train (and especially those who are being escorted down the aisle) should pay special attention to this.
- For “Keeping It Simple” and “All The Frills” weddings the church is decorated, in advance, for you. These would include, wreaths on the front door, lighted lanterns, window and pew decorations. Because of the number of weddings we perform on a single day we do not allow wedding parties to bring their own decorations - other than boutonnieres and bouquets for the wedding party.
- If you intend to have flower girls as part of your wedding party please make sure that all petals are gathered before you leave the sanctuary.
- Men are required to remove hats, caps, etc. as they enter the church building.
- Please do not bring food or drinks into the church.
- Because of the age of the church and its contents we request that wedding parties and guests do not touch or move any of the furniture or objects.
- The pastor at The Little Brown Church performs all weddings and vow renewals at the church. In “All The Frills” (60 minute weddings) your own pastor may be allowed to participate in the service (prayer, short word of encouragement).

- Any participation by outside clergy would need to be approved by our pastor at least 14 days before the service.
- In order to reduce the risk of fire we do not allow open flames anywhere in the church building.
- Bathrooms are located in the basement of the church. There is a ramp leading from the front door of the church to the bathrooms. *PLEASE NOTE: The changing rooms located in the basement of the church office/parsonage are NOT handicap accessible.*

PHOTOGRAPHY

The Little Brown Church in the Vale is one of the most photographed churches in Iowa, if not the entire United States! Whether Spring, Summer, Fall... or even Winter... the church, gardens and grounds of The Little Brown Church are the perfect place for your wedding photography.

INSIDE THE CHURCH

- All photography inside the church must take place within the time frame of the type of wedding or vow renewal that has been selected.
 - Just Us - 15/20 mins
 - Keeping It Simple - 30 mins
 - All The Frills - 60 mins
- Photography inside the church will not be permitted to continue beyond that time as there may be a wedding or vow renewal immediately following your ceremony.
- Couples who plan to use professional photographers are encouraged to select the "All The Frills" (60 minute) ceremony. This type of ceremony which allows plenty of time for photographs to be taken inside the church after the wedding ceremony.
- Flash photography is allowed in the church.
- There is no restriction regarding where your photographer can be located in the sanctuary to take your photographs. Standing on the pews, however, is not allowed.

ON THE GROUNDS

- You can take pictures on the church grounds both before AND after your ceremony

PLEASE NOTE: It is the responsibility of the bride or groom to inform their photographer of these guidelines

GETTING READY FOR YOUR WEDDING

We want you to be as prepared as possible for your big day. Here are a few things to remember:

- **MARRIAGE LICENSE:** You will need to provide a valid marriage license when you check in with at our church office the day of your wedding. You can obtain an Iowa Marriage License from any county in the state of Iowa. PLEASE NOTE: There is a 3-day waiting period before a license can either be mailed to you or be picked up at the courthouse. The Iowa Marriage License does not expire unless it is not retrieved from the county registrar within six months of application. There is a link on "GETTING MARRIED AT LBC" page on this website that will take you to the registrar at Chickasaw County where you can apply for a marriage license.
- **COMPLETE THE "ADDITIONAL INFORMATION" FORM:** Remember to complete the "Additional Information" form located on the "THE NEXT STEP" page of our website. We recommend you complete the form as soon as possible after your wedding/vow renewal has been confirmed. The form should be submitted **no later than 14 days** before your ceremony.
- **PAY YOUR BALANCE:** Remember that the outstanding balance for your wedding or vow renewal must be paid at least **fourteen (14)** days prior to your ceremony. You can do this on the "MAKE A PAYMENT" page on our website

ON YOUR BIG DAY

BEFORE YOU LEAVE FOR THE CHURCH:

- If you are getting married - make sure you bring all relevant documents that were provided to you by the courthouse (especially your marriage license)
- If you are exchanging rings – make sure someone is delegated to keep charge of the rings (normally the best man's job). Have an "eyes on" policy – that is, the bride or groom should see the rings in someone's possession before you leave for the church.
- If you have chosen an "All The Frills" wedding and have selected to have a special ceremony (Unity Cross, Sand Ceremony etc.) don't forget to bring the materials with you.
- If you have chosen an "All The Frills" wedding and have selected to share personal vows don't forget to bring them with you.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE CHURCH

- Make sure you arrive at least 30 minutes before your ceremony along with your two witnesses. (witnesses are not required for a Vow Renewal ceremony).
- Go immediately to the church office (which is located directly across the street from the church) to complete your paperwork, to briefly meet with our wedding facilitator, and to change for your wedding (if you intend to use the dressing rooms).
- The dressing rooms are located in the downstairs of the church office
- Also note that, if you are using the dressing rooms, you will be required to take all your belongings with you when you leave for the ceremony, as there may be another wedding that will be using the dressing rooms immediately after you.
- If you have booked an “ALL THE FRILLS” wedding or vow renewal and have selected a special ceremony such as Sand, Unity, or Three-Fold Cord you will need to make sure that they are set up prior to the ceremony itself. Our wedding facilitator will assist you with this.
- Once the paperwork has been completed (and you have finished dressing for your ceremony) you should go immediately to the church where the pastor and wedding facilitator will be waiting for you.
